

Dear Parents,

The following is a summary of information on our Land Trust goals and expenditures for the 2015-16 school year.

- Goal 1:**        **By the end of the 2015-16 school year the students will increase their reading growth by one year.** Every student is being monitored individually on their guided reading levels. Each teacher adjusts these levels monthly according to growth. Several other tools are used to assist in the collection of data.
- Fountas /Pinnell Assessment (School-wide testing)
  - Dibels Test,(Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) (Grades 1-3) three times during the school year
  - SRI Test (Scholastic Reading Inventory). (Grades 3-6)
  - Language Arts Sage Testing (Grades 3-6) **Showed an increase of 7% school-wide**
- Goal 2:**        **To increase the proficiency on math benchmarks for the 2015-16 school year.** Sage testing scores reported an **increase of 11% in math.**

Our 2014-15 Land Trust Expenditures are as follows:

**Salaries, benefits: \$61,424** (Math Aides, Literacy Aides, Enrichment Aides)

**Professional & Technical Services: \$6,000** (Entrance fees for teacher workshops and conferences).

We are also pleased to report that Daybreak Elementary received an “A” Grade from the Utah State Office of Education.
